10. Granville Leveson Gower (1721-1803), styled Vct Trentham 1746-54; 2d E. Gower, 1754; cr. (1786) M. of Stafford.

11. Either the Hon. Richard Leveson Gower (1726-53), 4th son of the 1st E. Gower, or one of his uncles, the Hon. William Leveson Gower (ca 1696-1756) and the Hon. Baptist Leveson Gower (?1703-82); all M.P.s.

12. William Stanhope (ca 1683-1756), cr. (1730) Bn and (1742) E. of Harrington.

13. Possibly Philip Stanhope (1732-68), natural son of Lord Chesterfield.

14. Petronille Melusine de Schulenburg (1693-1778), cr. (1722) Cts of Walsingham, s.j.; m. (1733) Philip Dormer Stanhope, 4th E. of Chesterfield.

15. Lady Charlotte Hamilton (ca 1703-77), m. (1736) Charles Edwin.

16. Lady Charlotte Compton (d. 1770), m. (1751) Hon. George Townshend, 4th Vct Townshend, 1764; Bns Ferrers, s.j., 1749; Bns Compton, s.j., 1754.

17. Lady Caroline Keppel (1737-69), m. (1759) Robert Adair; and Lady Elizabeth Keppel (1739-68), m. (1764) Francis Russell, styled M. of Tavistock.

(1725-86), cr. (1782) Vct Keppel, Lady Albemarle's second son.

19. Lady Jane Hamilton (d. 1752), m. (1719) Lord Archibald Hamilton.

20. Probably Hon. Mary Clifford (1731-97), m. (1766) Sir Edward Smythe, 4th Bt.

21. Lady Isabella Finch (d. 1771), lady of the Bedchamber to Princess Amelia.

22. Richard Rigby (1722-88), politician.

23. Probably Frances Gibson Shephard (1734-1807), illegitimate dau. and heiress of Samuel Shepherd of Exning, Suffolk; m. (1758) Charles Ingram, 9th Vct Irvine. Her eldest dau. eventually married Lord Hertford's eldest son (*post* 25, 30 Sept. 1775).

24. John Hobart (1723-93), styled Bn Hobart 1746-56, 2d E. of Buckinghamshire, 1756.

25. Probably Sir John Saunders Sebright (1725-94), 6th Bt, 1761 (BERRY i. 286).

26. Hugh Smithson (after 1750, Percy) (1714 or 1715-86), 4th Bt, 2d E. of Northumberland, 1750, cr. (1766) D. of Northumberland; m. (1740) Lady Elizabeth Seymour (1716-76).
