

From CONWAY, ca Wednesday 20 November 1765

Missing; a 'short' letter mentioned by HW *post* 29 Nov. 1765, presumably answered *post* ca 29 Nov. 1765. Conjecturally dated a few days anterior to Conway's missing letter of ca 22 Nov. 1765.

From CONWAY, ca Friday 22 November 1765

Missing; a 'long' letter answered by HW *post* 29 Nov. 1765. Conjecturally dated by the approximate time it would take for a letter to reach Paris from London after it had been sent first to Fontainebleau (see *post* 29 Nov. 1765).

To HERTFORD, ca Saturday 23 November 1765

Missing; listed in 'Paris Journals' (DU DEFFAND v. 377) as sent 'by Col. [Edward] Ligonier.'

To CONWAY, ca Saturday 23 November 1765

Missing; listed in 'Paris Journals' (DU DEFFAND v. 377) as sent 'by Col. Ligonier.'

To LADY AILESURY, ca Saturday 23 November 1765

Missing; listed in 'Paris Journals' (DU DEFFAND v. 377) as sent 'by Colonel Ligonier' with a 'lappet' (a streamer for a lady's head-dress).

To CONWAY, ca Friday 29 November 1765

Missing; listed in 'Paris Journals' (DU DEFFAND v. 378) as sent 'on business,' 'by Louis's cousin.' Presumably the 'very long' letter in answer to Conway's missing 'short letter,' mentioned *post* 29 Nov. 1765.
