## VOLUME I

Page xvii, List of illustrations, *sub* William Cole by John Gooch, for now in the Spencer Collection, New York Public Library *read* now wsl.

Page xx, last line, *after* riddles' *add* (*Quarterly Review* June 1848, vol. lxxxiii, no. 165, pp. 112-13).

Page xxxvi, line 13, *for* Foster *read* Forster *after* 110. *insert* An autograph note signed 'H.W.', about the MSS of Cole's letters, was sold Sotheby's 27-28 Oct. 1981, lot 694.

Page xli, line 27, *after* New York City; *add* Guildhall Library;

Page li, line 3, *after* 1803.\* *insert* The text of Walpole's letters is taken from the original manuscripts, now Add. MSS 5952-5953. Cole made copies of Walpole's letters interspersed with copies of his own letters in his notebooks. We use Cole's copies to fill in illegible phrases and missing addresses in letters from Walpole. The text of Cole's letters is taken from the manuscripts in the Forster collection, Victoria and Albert Museum, from manuscripts at Nostell Priory, Wakefield, Yorks, or from Cole's own copies in his notebooks.
