

CHRONOLOGICAL LIST OF LETTERS

This is a list, by dates, of all existing letters to or from Horace Walpole, including fragmentary letters (or extracts from letters now lost), but *not* including letters which are completely missing, even though some information about them may have been printed from time to time in our volumes.

The letters preceding the change of calendar in 1752 are arranged in the sequence in which they were actually written, allowing eleven days' difference between 'new style' letters from the Continent, and 'old style' letters from England.

If more than one letter was written on any given day, the headings for the letters of that day are arranged alphabetically by names of correspondents.

If a letter can merely be assigned to a certain year or month, it is listed at the beginning of the letters for that year or month.

Later information has sometimes caused us to change the dating of certain letters which were printed in our earlier volumes. In the present list, we assign such letters to the corrected dates, even though the reader may yet be referred to the places originally assigned to those letters. When a letter has been completely reprinted in more correct form in one of the later volumes, the present list gives only the location of the correct text, but when mere corrections or additions are printed in the later volumes, the page numbers of both the original printings and the corrections or additions are included.

Certain letters cannot be given even approximate dates, and are therefore grouped at the end, alphabetically arranged according to correspondents' names.
